**Gwen Skloot** is Senior Vice President, Clinical Development at Altesa Biosciences. She is a clinical leader with 25 years of experience in academic pulmonary medicine and over 5 years in the biopharmaceutical industry.

Dr. Skloot served on the faculty of the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai from 1995 through 2020, attaining the rank of Professor of Medicine. She maintained a large clinical practice and led clinical research focused on obstructive airway diseases and pulmonary physiology. She has held multiple leadership roles within the American Thoracic Society, including service on its Board of Directors from 2017 to 2020.

In 2021, Dr. Skloot joined Chiesi USA in Global Clinical Development, where she advanced to Therapy Area Head for Asthma, COPD, and Chronic Cough. In this role, she contributed across the full spectrum of clinical development (Phase I–III), led due diligence evaluations, and played a key role in regulatory submissions for asthma and COPD. Dr. Skloot received her undergraduate degree from Johns Hopkins University and her medical degree from New York University. She completed her residency in Internal Medicine at The Mount Sinai Medical Center and her fellowship in Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine at The Johns Hopkins Medical Institute.
